




NCDA Benchmarking Tool

The NCD Alliance



Snapshot of National/Regional Alliances

The Healthy Caribbean Coalition (HCC):

- Formed in 2008 –consists of 40
 Caribbean- based health NGOs and over 45 not-for-profits
- In official relations with PAHO/WHO
- Produced Caribbean Civil Society
 Status Report; evidence base for NCD advocacy for NGOs in the region

Norwegian NCD Alliance:

- Helped develop Norwegian NCD strategy.
- Plays a pivotal role in implementation of the strategy, e.g. through USD 250,000 grant from Directorate of Health for a campaign to promote physical activity.
- Regularly consulted by MoH on global and national NCD processes.

Zanzibar NCD Alliance (Z-NCDA):

- Public awareness campaign, incl. radio and television programmes, education materials, community outreach events, establishment of network of volunteers
- Regularly engages MoH/NCD Focal Point
- Undergone period of in-depth organisational capacity-building

Alliance for Tobacco Control and Health (ACT+ Brazil):

- Focuses on tobacco control and NCDs
- Advocacy; communication; implementation; research and monitoring of WHO FCTC and NCD GAP
- Launched Brazilian CSR in 2014, calling for integrated approach to epidemic



Twinning Initiatives

The Danish NCD Alliance:

- Informal alliance between Danish Heart Foundation, Danish Diabetes Association, Danish Cancer Society
- Funded through grant from DANIDA

Established East Africa NCD Alliance Initiative in 2012:

- Includes Tanzania, Zanzibar, Kenya, Rwanda, Uganda
- Launch of East Africa NCD Civil Society Status Report.

Formed a **twinning initiative** with **Uganda NCD Alliance** (UNCDA) in 2009 to strengthen capacity through:

- Learning/Training Exchanges
- Fundraising
- Technical support
- Disease surveillance

Global NCD Alliance Forum



Audience:

- 80+ national and regional NCD alliance representatives
 (3 per regional alliance; 2 per national alliance)
- 100 key NCD stakeholders from across sectors

Purpose:

- First ever forum to convene representatives from growing network of national and regional NCD alliances;
- Platform for knowledge exchange, capacity building, priority setting, and facilitating north-south and south-south cooperation.



Global NCD Alliance Forum



Provisional Programme:

- Day 1 site visits in Sharjah; welcome reception.
- Day 2-3 packed with plenary sessions, interactive workshops, and networking sessions.
- Workshops cover 3 themes: advocacy;
 organisational development; and accountability.
- Focus will be on interactive sessions, with practical case studies, examples, good practice.
