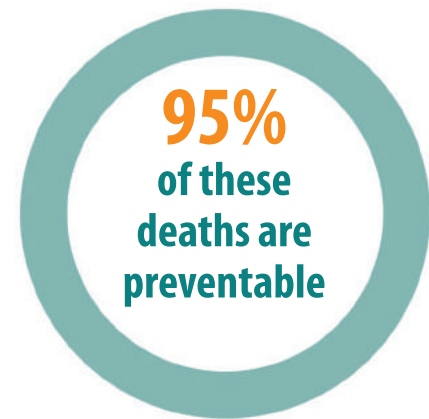


The Caribbean Civil Society Cervical Cancer Prevention Initiative (C4PI)



The HCC, the Australian Direct Aid Program & the American Cancer Society are working to empower Caribbean Cancer Societies to respond more effectively to the community-based needs for cervical cancer prevention, treatment and control.

January 2014 - to date

2700+ hard to reach, vulnerable women educated and screened for cervical cancer

Cervical Cancer Survivor & Guyana C4PI project documentaries produced

10400 materials developed and disseminated to support cervical cancer awareness education

HPV and Cervical Cancer Position Statement developed

60 uninsured Dominican women provided with vouchers for cervical cancer treatment

HCC regional *End Cervical Cancer Now* Electronic Petition (CCCEP) supported by all 5 subgrantees (www.endcervicalcancer.org)

79 outreach workers trained in counselling and screening (Pap Tests and VIA - Visual Inspection with Acetic Acid)

Radio jingle produced and aired in Grenada

22+ community outreach sessions conducted
