

CHILDHOOD OBESITY PREVENTION SCORECARD (COPS) REGIONAL SNAPSHOT HCC supports the WHO recommended comprehensive approach to prevention of childhood overweight and obesity, which includes the implementation of key policies such as: Taxation of SSBs; Regulation of Marketing to Children; Mandatory Front of Package Nutritional Labelling; and School Policies. The HCC CSAP Childhood Obesity Prevention Scorecard (COPS) has 16 indicators to measure a country's response to responses to childhood overweight and obesity.
