


The **Acute Psychiatric Unit** provides mental health care to all Dominicans of all ages. Its main function is the assessment, diagnosis and treatment of patients in an acute care setting. Additionally we provide Consultation Liaison Psychiatry service to the Dominica China Friendship Hospital including crisis management and critical incidents which extends to the Primary Health Care Services, communities and other government services. We also provide mental health services to the communities in Dominica through a referral system with the Primary Health Care Services.

ACCESSING SERVICES:

UNDER 18?:

Referrals, which can be issued by physicians and the Court are **mandatory to access services**.

You also **need parent consent** to access services and need to be accompanied by a trusted adult. You can bring a friend to the appointment.

**Patients are required to walk with their medical book whenever they come for review.*

18 AND OVER?:

You can also access services by **walking in** in which case you will be assessed to determine whether you meet the criteria for admission.

**Patients are required to walk with their medical book whenever they come for review.*

Wait time for appointment: Less than 1 week
Typical length of session: 30 minutes to 45 minutes

Wait time for appointment: Less than 1 week
Typical length of session: 45 minutes to 1 hour

ACCESSING SERVICES:

UNDER 18?:

You can access services by **referral** which are **mandatory** to assist with investigations and provision of support. Referrals can be by the Police, Teachers, Health Professionals and the Honorable Court.

You can also **walk in but only if an emergency**.

You **need to have parent consent** to access services and you must be accompanied by a trusted adult.

18 AND OVER?:

You can make appointments over the **phone**, **in person** by visiting the facility and **referral**.

Appointments are mandatory.

You can **walk in** to access services.

Wait time for appointment: Less than 1 week
Typical length of session: 30 to 45 minutes

OFFICE OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT

The **Office of Disaster Management** coordinates the implementation of Comprehensive Disaster Management (CDM) in the Commonwealth of Dominica through the [National Emergency Planning Organization \(NEPO\)](#), a governmental organization with responsibility for the planning and organization of counter-disaster measures at central level.

The Office of Disaster Management does not offer MHPSS Services as it primarily serves as a coordinating mechanism in disasters. They may make referrals to other agencies as needed.
